Oppen

The tail marking method with Oppen is suitable for short-term identifications.

Compared to ear punching or ear tagging, this method is less stressful for the animal and easier for the experimenter.



Capable of marking the tail and skin not only of albino mice but also of colored mice such as C57BL/6.

The inks used for these markers are safe for animals.

The fine-tip marker is specially designed for writing, allowing small numbers and characters to be marked clearly and precisely without smudging.

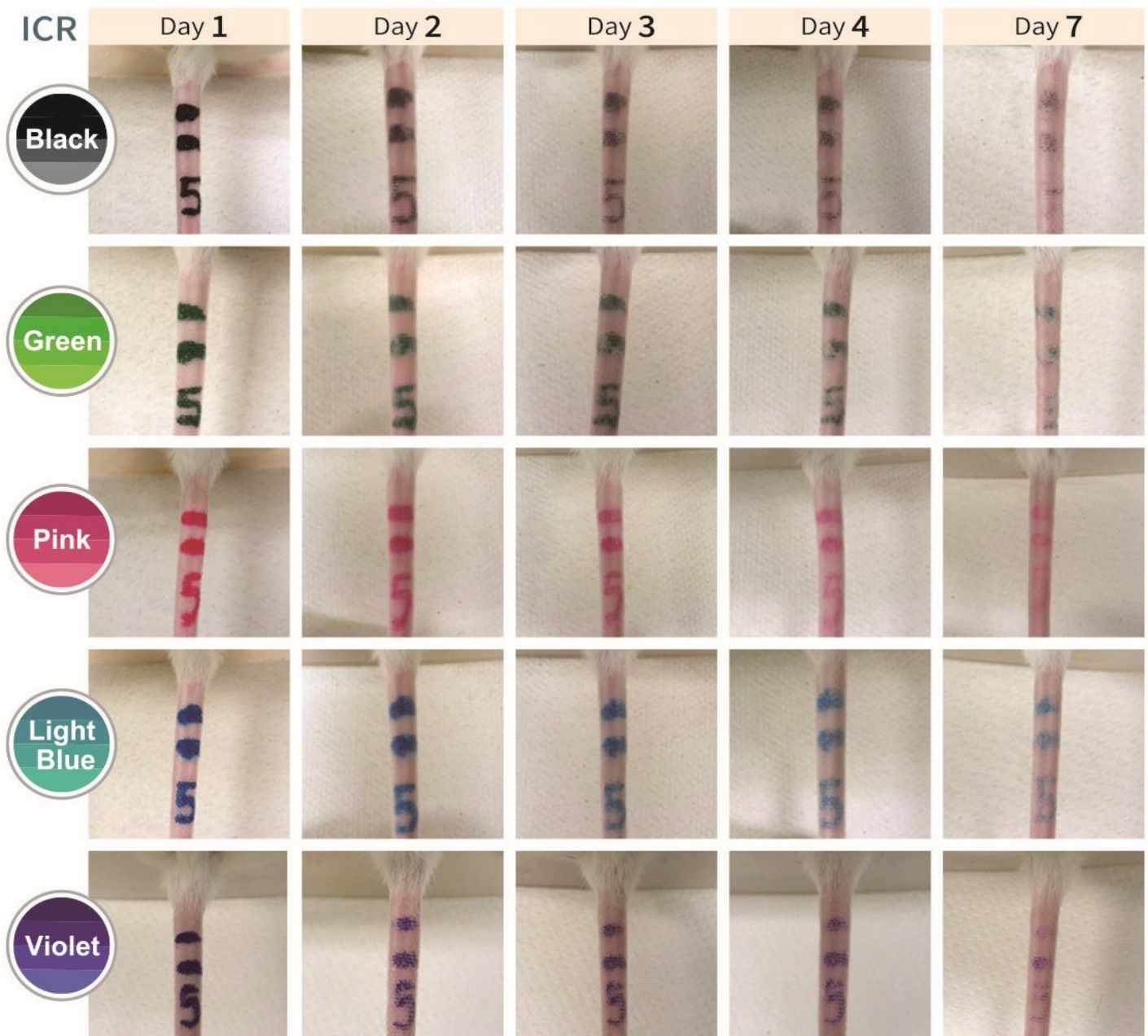

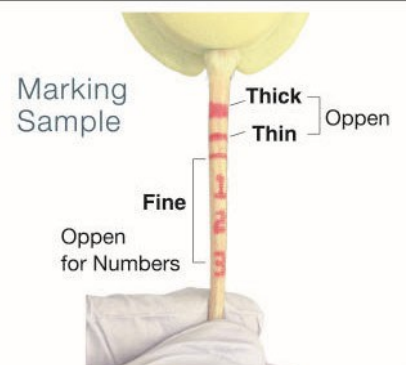
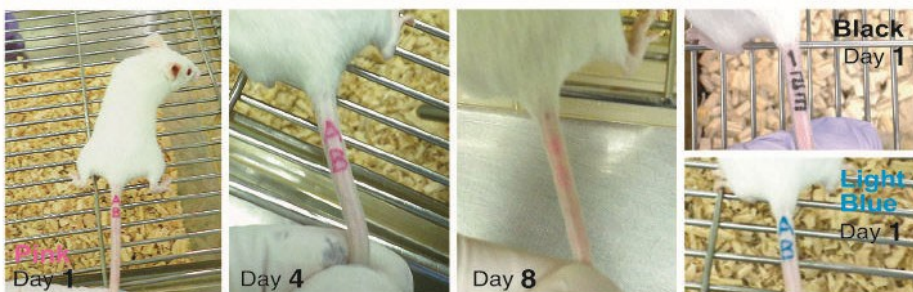
